languages, occupational units and social-political groups.

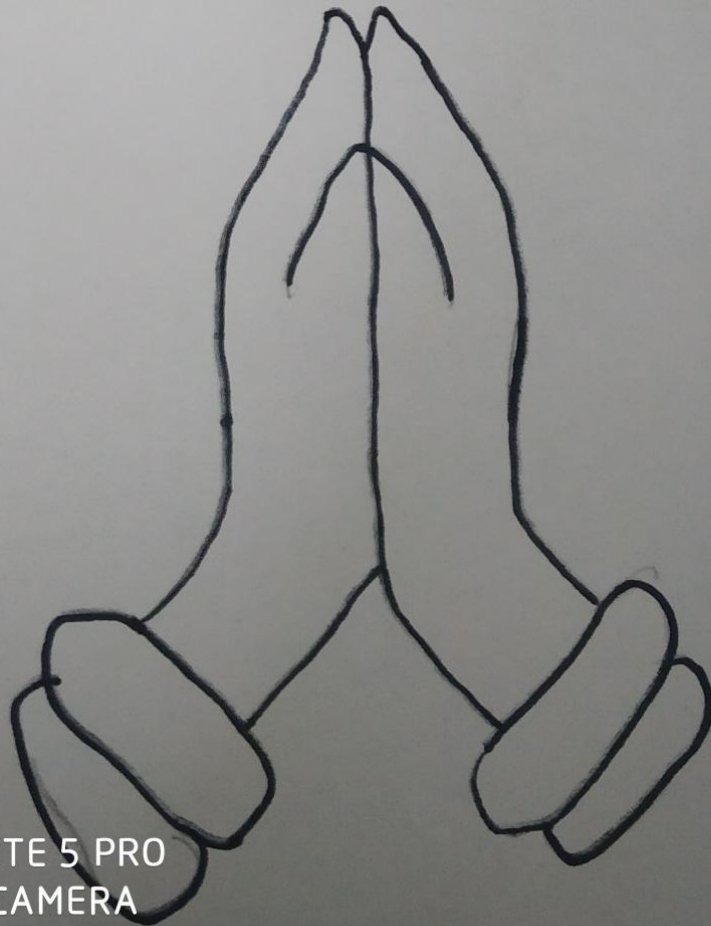
