7th August 2026 - Bonalu Celebrations

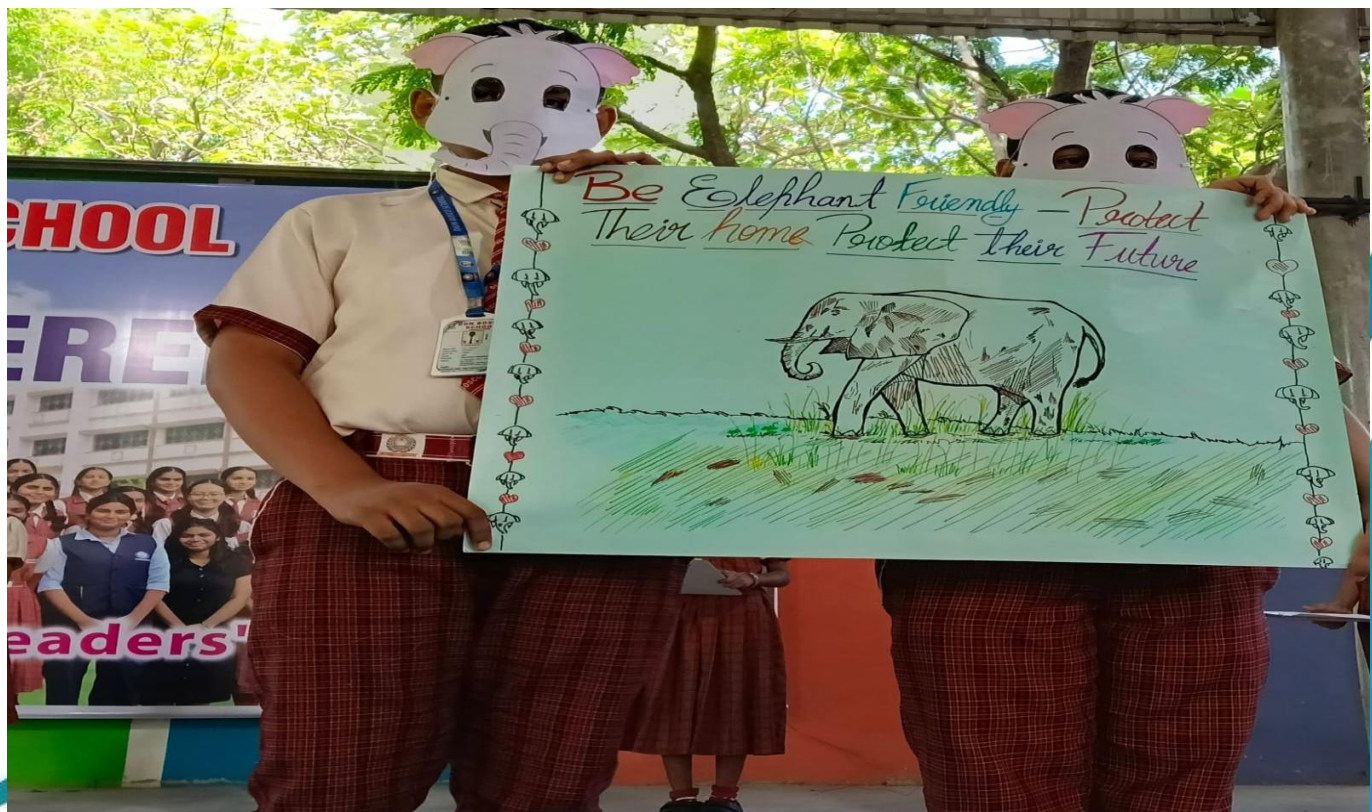
